Governor Speaks at Annual Meeting!

Lower Valley Energy held its Annual Meeting on July 24th at the Jackson High School with over 80 people in attendance. Dr. Jim Little, Chairman of the Board of Directors, introduced Governor Dave Freudenthal.

The governor talked about his experiences with co-ops growing up and how much he enjoyed attending co-op annual meetings. "And I commend you for stepping forward [to provide natural gas service]

when no one else would," "and for being one of Wyoming's quiet success stories" he told LVE members.

The governor moved on to "commend [our] involvement in green power. If Wyoming is going to fully participate in an energy future, we have to make green power available. We have to have green power to put in the electricity mix."

Chairman Dr. Jim Little presented officials from the hospital with a donation of \$1,000. Dr. Little noted it was the sense of community pride and service that made Wyoming and rural America such a wonderful place to live and work.

Treasurer Fred Brog reported that the co-op generated \$30.5 million in electricity revenue and \$5.6 million in gas revenue.

During his report, President/CEO Jim Webb talked about our transition from a truck delivery system for natural gas to a pipeline delivery system. He also addressed the question LVE staff members hear most often, "what will happen to rates when the contract with BPA expires in 2006?" "The answer," Webb said, "is that rates are expected to increase between 15 to 25 percent."

Webb also paid tribute to LVE employees. "We have the best group of employees we could ever assemble. In 2003, we had 76 employees and that included the six we added to do the natural gas side of our business. In 1999, with 86 employees, our productivity was 183 meters per employee. By 2003, our productivity had increased to 326 meters per employee."

LVE's auditor was pleased to report that 20 percent of the membership voted. Directors Fred Brog and Dean Lewis were re-elected to 3-year terms.

Power & Gas Supply Update

Public scoping for the proposed Lower Valley Energy natural gas pipeline was held on July 13th in the Teton County Library and in Bondurant on July 13. The meetings were well attended and Lower Valley Energy appreciates the input of customers and local citizens into this exciting project. Forest Service officials, along with Lower Valley Energy representatives, engineering specialists and environmental specialists were on hand to address any questions and to solicit comments and concerns from those in attendance.

Lower Valley Energy is proposing to build an 8-inch natural gas pipeline from the Merna gas field area just south of Bondurant, through the Hoback Canyon and into Jackson to serve the energy needs of our community. Lower Valley Energy is pursuing this project to help stabilize the price of natural gas for our consumers. The pipeline would eliminate the need to liquefy and truck the gas into Jackson. Last year alone, Lower Valley Energy received 492 truckloads of liquefied natural gas at our Jackson facility. This number is expected to steadily increase up to 665 trucks per year by 2010. The pipeline would also provide many environmental benefits besides eliminating the need for a significant amount of truck traffic to Jackson to deliver the natural gas. Visual impacts would be minimal and the pipeline is projected to also improve reliability and provide cost savings in later years. This will also help Lower Valley Energy even further improve its service and price stability to our customers.

It is estimated that the Environmental Impact Study process will proceed through spring 2006 with actual construction to start that summer and to be completed by late fall of the same year. Lower Valley Energy is continuing to work on all aspects of this project and would welcome customer comments, both positive and negative, regarding this project and how we can best mitigate its impact while maximizing the benefits to the community and our customers.

Stable Energy Rates

Integrated Resource Plan – Energy Negotiations

Lower Valley Energy's leadership among utilities in Wyoming and the Northwest in providing low-cost quality service to our members is due in part to the competitive wholesale power supply contracts we have been able to secure over the years. In 1995 we negotiated the first of two long-term fixed cost power supply contracts with the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), headquartered in Portland, Oregon. Since that time, the power supply market has been very volatile and Lower Valley has been fortunate to avoid some very significant rate increases experienced by many other utilities across the country. Those contracts along with many other cost-saving measures, have aided Lower Valley in maintaining very

stable electric rates. The year 2003 marked our 10th year in a row without an electric rate increase.

The fixed rate portion of our contract with BPA continues for another two years and will end October 1st, 2006. The Board and management of Lower Valley have been working diligently to meet our members post-2006 power supply needs by exploring the lowest cost, most reliable mix of power supply resources. In addition to continuing to work with BPA, we have been working with many potential supplemental power suppliers to diversify our power supply portfolio and to meet some of Lower Valley's projected load growth. During 2003 we continued negotiations on a power supply contract with Grant County Public Utility District in Ephrata, Washington. Grant County efficiently operates two large hydroelectric facilities on the Columbia River. We continued extensive discussions with Deseret Power, a generating and transmission cooperative in

Salt Lake City that owns and operates a coal-fired generating facility in Utah. We also furthered talks with Pacific Northwest Generating Cooperative in Portland, Oregon who is a power supply aggregator owned by a group of electric cooperatives across the Pacific Northwest. Lower Valley Energy already added a successful wind power option for our customers and a slate of innovative conservation programs are available. Renewable power resources and conservation programs will likely be an important part of Lower Valley's power supply portfolio long into the future.

The Lower Valley Energy Board of Directors hired E3, an engineering, economics, and environmental consulting firm located in San Francisco, California, to complete an extensive Integrated Resource Plan (IRP). The IRP will explore all the power supply options already mentioned and evaluate many other options culminating in a model which will quantify the least cost mix of resources to meet Lower Valley's future energy needs and will help guide Lower Valley Energy's post-2006 power supply decisions. The plan is scheduled to be completed this fall and will be available for public comment. Public meetings will be held later this fall once the IRP is completed. Please plan to attend and share your thoughts and comments about power supply options with us. This is an important time for all of us as we plan our energy future and thoroughly review all options available to us.

Recycle Your Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs

Although we've officially ended our Compact Fluorescent Light bulb Giveaway, we need to be conscious now more than ever of recycling them. Compact fluorescent light bulbs use just a quarter of the energy than standard incandescent light bulbs and last up to ten times longer. Because of their mercury content, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has determined that compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs) need to be recycled. In Teton County, recycle your CFLs by appointment at Jackson Community Recycling south of town on Highway 89. Call 733-7678 for an appointment on either the first or last Tuesday of each month. In Star Valley, Lower Valley Energy has placed an enclosed bin outside near the front office for you to recycle your CFLs. Thank you for recycling CFLs and for participating in our CFL program! Compact fluorescent light bulbs are a great and easy energy saving resource.
